What is Suspicious?

Anything that seems even slightly "out of place" for the area or time of day in which it occurs is suspicious.

Obvious things to watch for include:

- A STRANGER ENTERING YOUR NEIGHBOR'S HOUSE WHEN IT IS UNOCCUPIED.
- A SCREAM HEARD ANYWHERE.
- OFFERS OF MERCHANDISE AT RIDICULOUSLY LOW PRICES CAN MEAN STOLEN PROPERTY.
- ANYONE REMOVING ACCESSORIES, LICENSE PLATES OR GASOLINE FROM A CAR.
- ANYONE PEERING INTO PARKED CARS.
- THE SOUND OF BREAKING GLASS OR OTHER LOUD EXPLOSIVE NOISES.
- PERSONS PEEPING IN WINDOWS.
- PERSONS LOITERING AROUND SECLUDED AREAS OR IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD.
- PERSONS AROUND THE NEIGHBORHOOD WHO DO NOT LIVE THERE.
